IT'S TIME NOW TO PLANT A TREE FOR THE FUTURE!

Take part in beautifying our neighborhood by scheduling a canopy tree to be planted in your street-facing easement. The City of Bellemeade encourages residents to plant trees by budgeting funds each year to assist residents with the cost of planting trees. Through the tree planting rebate program, you may be eligible for up to \$150 per tree.



While it is recommended that you use an insured landscaper or arborist, residents can choose an arborist of their choice. Recommended trees are Red Maple, Willow Oak, White Oak, and Tulip Poplar.
