AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE GENERAL OPERATING PURPOSES OF AND THE CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF BELLEMEADE, KENTUCKY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 - 2020 FROM JULY 1, 2019 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020

This budget is based on the projected non-compensating real estate tax rate on PVA Evaluation for Tax Year 2019. The City shall not collect more than four percent (4%) in dollars and cents than it collected in the prior tax year without public referendum. Property Tax due bills shall be mailed to property owners in September of the tax year.

- 4. The City Treasurer is empowered to expend money within the above limitations upon the review and approval of the City Commission.
- 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Bellemeade and publication as required by law.
