AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE GENERAL OPERATING PURPOSES OF AND THE CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF BELLEMEADE, KENTUCKY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 FROM JULY 1, 2022 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023

Section 3. This budget is based on the projected non-compensating real estate tax rate on PVA Evaluation for the Tax Year 2022. The City shall not collect more than four percent (4%) in dollars and cents than it collected in the prior tax year without public referendum. Property Tax due bills shall be mailed to property owners in September of the tax year unless otherwise noted in the Tax ordinance

Section 4. The City Treasurer is empowered to expend money within the above limitations upon review and approval of the appropriate members of the City Commission.

Section 5. This Ordinance supersedes and repeals all previous Ordinances to the extent that they may be in conflict herewith.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect from and after passage by the City Commissioners and publication as required by law.
